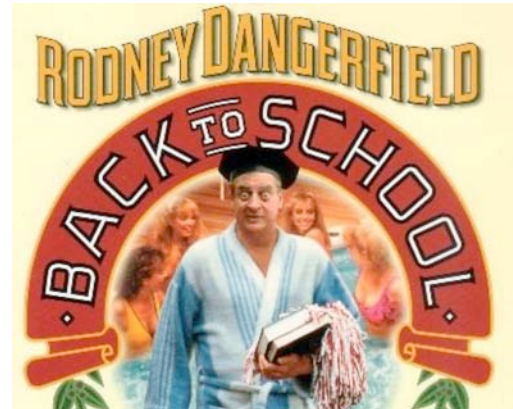


Fall Classes
